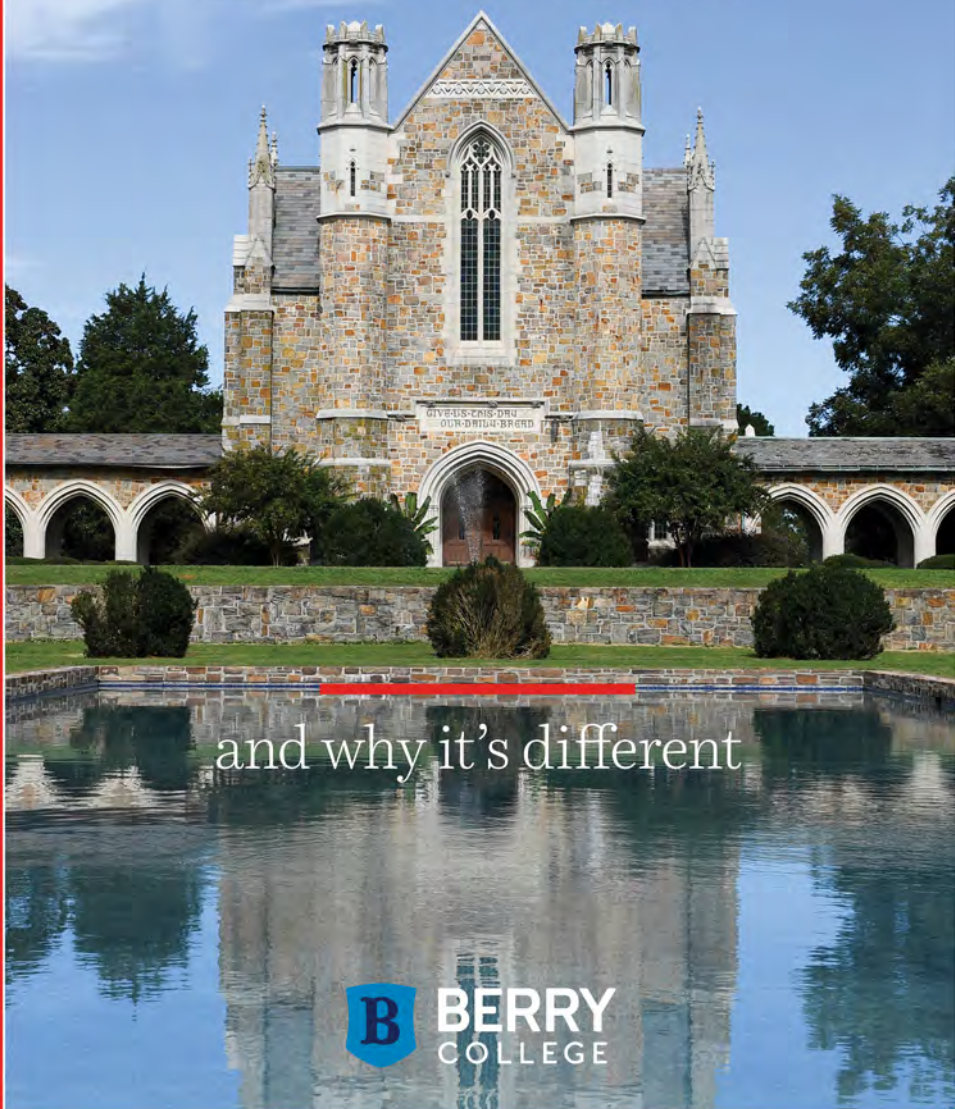

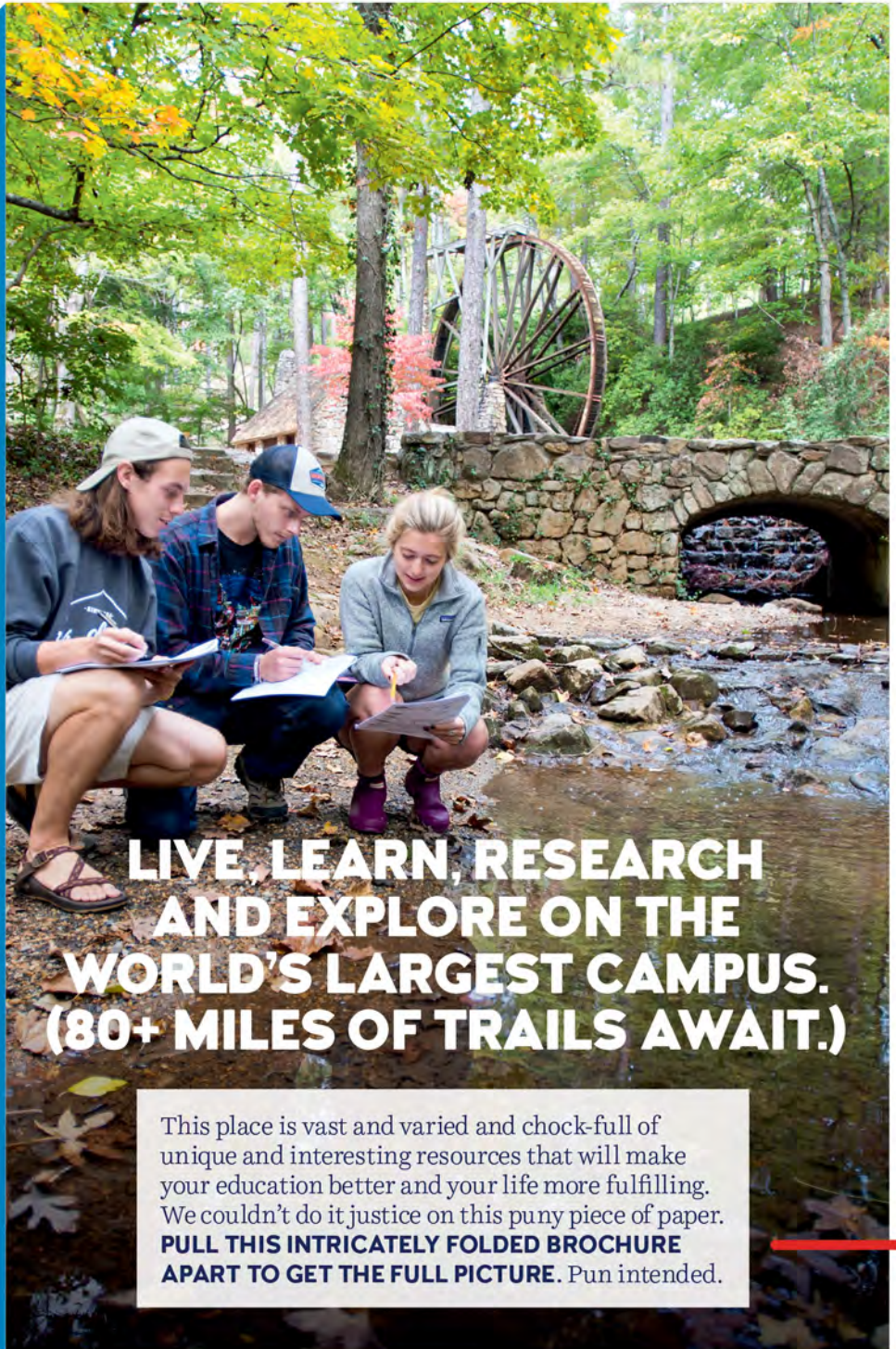

## ENROLLMENT

We are **approximately 2,000** undergrads from **35** states and **18** countries — and with **many** opinions, perspectives and points of view.

## FACULTY

We are guided by **163** full-time faculty, **92%** of whom hold a Ph.D. or equivalent degree.

Mentioning our **11:1** student-to-faculty ratio is just our way of quantifying the fact that our professors **know us as individuals** and **teach us accordingly**.

## FINANCIAL AID AND SCHOLARSHIPS

Yes, college is expensive (though Berry is **less so** than many other selective private colleges).

We like to think of Berry as an **investment**, a chance to get the **best possible education** (and so to live the **best possible version** of your life).

Berry helps families **manage college costs** through a combination of **merit scholarships, need-based financial aid grants and financing plans** that spread payments throughout the year.
