

All great institutions have great faculty. Berry is no exception. We could list the national accolades, impressive degrees and scholarly research of our faculty. Instead, we think our alumni offer a more convincing commentary on what sets our professors apart:

In the spring semester of my freshman year, a friend and I were taking an economics class, and late one night we were cramming hard for our first big test. Around 11 p.m., we decided to move from our dorms to the Waffle House. On the way there, we randomly drove past our professor, who was taking a late-night jog. We talked for a moment, told him we were headed off to study for his test and moved on. Less than an hour later, he showed up at the Waffle House to help us study... and stayed until 1 or 2 a.m.

At Berry, professional staff employ, supervise, evaluate and guide students who work in every facet of the college – from the marketing office to the equestrian center, from research labs to the library.
