## MLK BE LOVE DAY

The Office of Diversity & Inclusion, The Chaplain's Office, Lettie Pate Whitehead Scholars Program, and Berry College Volunteer Services hosted *BE LOVE Day* in observance of Martin Luther King Jr. Day on Monday. The day kicked off with a church service featuring keynote speaker Mairo Akpose-Simpson, a Berry Alumna and Board of Trustee member. Following the service, The Lettie Pate Whitehead Scholars Program hosted lunch along with guided discussion on Dr. King's legacy. Lastly, 200 students, faculty, and staff served in our community at various sites organized by Berry College Volunteer Services.

### REMINDER: SCHOLARSHIPS FOR CURRENT STUDENTS

The Office of Financial Aid is hosting three information sessions next week for current students interested in applying for scholarships and additional financial aid for the 2023-24 academic year.
