## PREPARING FOR MIDTERMS

Over the last six weeks, the Academic Success Center has provided hundreds of ASC Sessions (Berry's version of tutoring) to help students succeed in their courses. For so many of Berry's Foundations courses (think everything from Spanish to Psychology to Chemistry to Calculus), ASC Sessions are available Sunday through Thursday evenings from 5:00 to 10:00 pm in Memorial Library. Students don't need to schedule appointments or sign up for anythingthough it's always a good idea to check the schedule of sessions here. Students also don't need to wait until confusion sets in to walk into The Commons. These are casual Q&A and homework help sessions and are the perfect place for students to work through homework assignments or study for exams. Our trained and knowledgeable peer tutors are on hand, so when questions arise students only need to raise a hand to get the answers they need to keep making progress. Our supportive student and professional staff-and the nearby coffee shop-could be just what your student needs as courses become more intense in the second half of the semester.

On October 5th, students also received access to their Midterm Progress Reports from faculty. These provide important feedback to your student about their academic progress and can be a starting point for important conversations with you, faculty, their advisor, coaches, scholarship coordinators, or other mentors in their lives. For most students, there will be both successes to celebrate and changes to make after receiving this feedback. Please encourage your students to check their midterm progress reports and reach out with questions, concerns, or any need they may have.

The Health Center staff can help students manage most minor illnesses and injuries and offer treatment onsite. We can provide prescriptions and referrals for more specialized care when appropriate. We also provide flu shots, point-ofcare testing (COVID, strep, flu, mono, etc.) routine injections, gynecological services, STI screening, and more. Most of the services we offer are covered by student fees, and there is no additional charge.

Another important part of our mission is to promote student wellness through awareness and education. Important events and announcements are posted on social media and Berry Connect. We send occasional reminders via SMS text messaging. In order to receive texts, students must opt-in by editing their profile in the Medicat Patient Portal.

As always, confidentiality is a core duty of any health care provider, and student privacy is very important to us. We encourage all students to utilize the Health Center as an important resource as they begin to make self-directed health care decisions.
