GAIN PROFESSIONAL EXPERIENCE

On average, Berry students will gain **1400 hours** of work experience and hold 5 different jobs over 4 years. Often, students will find a campus department or LifeWorks position that they want to grow in...and many will have the opportunity to advance into higher roles.

LifeWorks jobs are classified by level of responsibility: **Entry, Intermediate, Advanced, and Pre-Professional.**

PRACTICE PROFESSIONAL COMMUNICATION

LifeWorks equips students for real-world job applications through immersive practice, tailored guidance, and meaningful feedback.

- 1. RESUME FEEDBACK:** To apply or be promoted to positions beyond entry-level, students must complete a resume training that includes receiving in-depth feedback and approval from trained professionals
- 2. JOB APPLICATIONS:** As students seek out additional LifeWorks positions, they will gain invaluable experience as they practice applying for each job.
- 3. JOB INTERVIEWS:** Students also gain experience (and constructive feedback) as they interview for each new LifeWorks position. Supervisors ask students interview questions that align with the appropriate job level, becoming more complex as students move into upper-level positions.

ANNUAL EVALUATIONS
