SERVICES PROVIDED FOR ADDITIONAL FEES

The following services are billed to insurance if the student is covered:

- Labs: Student will need to go off campus if lab work is required, but they will follow up for results in the Health Center
- X-rays: Student will need to go off campus for x-rays
- STI testing with urine (Chlamydia, Gonorrhea, Trichomoniasis)
 - \$39 per test
- Pap smears
- COVID-19 Molecular lab billed to insurance and the CARES Act per providing lab.

INJECTABLE MEDICATIONS PROVIDED

- Rocephin (Antibiotic)
- DepoMedrol (Steroid)
- Toradol (Anti-inflammatory)
- EpiPen (If needed for anaphylaxis)
- Benadryl (Antihistamine)
- Zofran (Anti-Nausea)
- Phenergan (Anti-Nausea)
- Flu Vaccines (Usually starting in October)
- Narcan (Nasal spray to reverse opioid overdose)
